### **BOOK WEEK Monday 5th – Friday 9th February 2018.**

Our focus for the week will be: **Fairy Tales**. All children will experience, watch, listen to, and read a selection of *Fairy Tale* stories - before attempting to recreate their own exciting tale with a twist (e.g. The Three Little Wolves and the Big Bad Pig). Throughout the week, everyone in school will be involved in a variety of exciting activities; this includes a range of competitions, where winners will be rewarded at the 'Fantastic Finish' assembly.

The week will begin with a super start assembly, on **Monday 5th February**. Each day, our **very talented teachers** will perform a re-enactment of their favourite classic *Fairy Tales*. The children are invited to bring a donation of **£2.00 per child** to contribute towards the weekly activities.

On **Tuesday 6th February**, they will enjoy popcorn and a film in class to celebrate different *Fairy Tale* stories.

**Thursday 8th February** will be dressing up day and **Friday 9th February** will be our carousel day. We encourage the children to dress up as a character from a *Fairy Tale*. They will take part in a catwalk parade to celebrate (No football kits are to be worn and ensure that all outfits are weather appropriate) .

The Book Fairs will be open, for parents and children: **Tuesday for Infants** and Wednesday for Juniors after school each day until **4.30pm**. Children can use their World Book Day vouchers at the Book Fair to purchase a book.

As in previous years, St Elphege's are going to be taking part in a 'Readathon' to help children in hospitals. Children who raise the most money will be awarded a special prize to recognise their efforts.
