Full Governing Board	Tom Tamplin	<p>The Board of Governors is responsible for the strategic direction and accountability of the schools in the Federation. It has a responsibility for determining, monitoring and keeping under review the broad policies and procedures within which the schools operate.</p> <p>As a Federation of Catholic Schools, the Board of Governors has a particular responsibility for understanding, maintaining and developing the distinctive nature of the schools and ensuring that the schools' religious education and worship are in accordance with the teachings, doctrines, discipline and general and particular norms of the Catholic Church,</p>
Curriculum	Marsha Dann	<p>The role of the Curriculum Committee is to increase governors' awareness of the school curriculum and its development; and also to inform the Board of Governors about the attainment and achievement of all pupils in general, and vulnerable groups in particular.</p>
Finance	Ravi Ravendran	<p>Role of the Finance Committee:</p> <p>The role of the finance committee is primarily to provide financial oversight for the Federation. Typical task areas for the schools includes: budgeting and financial planning, financial management and reporting, and the creation and monitoring of internal controls and accountability policies. An outline of responsibilities follows:</p> <p>Budgeting and Financial Planning: Develop and approve an annual and multi-year operating budget for Schools.</p> <p>Financial Management and Reporting: Monitor and Manage Income/expenditure against plan and report to the board of governors.</p> <p>Internal Control, Accountability Policies and Auditing: Ensure policies and procedures for financial transactions are documented in a manual, and the manual is reviewed annually, and updated as necessary and also approved financial policies and procedures are being followed. Review and present the audit report to the full board of governors.</p>
Premises & Health and Safety	Shiela Morris	<p>The purpose of the Committee is to ensure that the Federation establishes and implements policies that provide a healthy and safe environment for pupils and staff. Working with Federation senior management it identifies building requirements and school maintenance programmes and ensures that these are carried out within Local Authority and building regulations.</p>
Staffing	Anne Hurley	<p>The Staffing Committee provides guidance to the Board on all matters relating to personnel issues. It considers the personnel implications of the School Improvement Plan, including staff training; applies the provisions of the whole school pay policy and appraisal provisions; ensures the Board follows safer recruitment practice in appointing staff to vacancies; considers issues relating to staff grievance; discipline and capability issues; considers appeals made by any member of staff; monitors staff absence.</p>
Monitoring and Evaluation	Tom Tamplin	<p>On behalf of the Board of Governors, the Monitoring and Evaluation Committee ensures the Federation is achieving its aims and objectives through the detailed monitoring of the schools' results; pupils' attainment and progress; and the implementation of the school development plans. We take the lead in developing and implementing major strategic, organisational and physical changes to the Federation and its schools. We oversee the development and implementation of all policies and procedures which do not fall within the remit of other committees.</p>
